Day Care Safety Checklist



Walls and Windows

- ☐ Electrical outlets covered.
- \square Wall paint is not peeling.
- $\ensuremath{\square}$ Electrical cords are in good condition and well out of reach of children.
- ☐ Windows have window guards that can be opened by adults in an emergency.
- ☐ Window drapes are secured.
- \square Exterior doors are secured to keep children from wandering out.
- 🛮 Items on shelves are out of reach of children
- ☐ Cabinets not for children have safety latches
- All cleaning products are secured and away from children

Infant Cribs and Changing Tables

- $\hfill \square$ Cribs are free of pillows or stuffed animals and bumper pads.
- \square Cribs have mattresses that fit snugly and sheets that fit securely.
- $\hfill\square$ Cribs and changing-table items are regularly washed with gentle, baby-safe detergents.
- \square Changing tables are sanitary and stocked with supplies such as wipes and diaper-rash cream.





Indoor Play Areas and Adjoining Rooms

- \square Floors are free of clutter. Rugs are non-skid.
- $\ \square$ Toys are clean, in good repair and safe for your child's age.
- Heavy items (TVs, large furniture) are secured so that children can't turn them over.
- \square Hot surfaces, such as radiators and stoves, are out of children's reach.

Outdoor Play Areas

- ☐ Play area is completely fenced
- \square Play equipment is safe, well maintained and appropriate for children's age.
- ☐ No areas of standing water which attract mosquitos.
- $\ \square$ No hazards that could cause tripping or strangulation, such as dangling cords.
- ☐ No peeling paint.
- \square All lawn equipment and poisons are secured and out of reach of children.
- No protruding nails, bolts, splintered wood or other items that could cause injury.
- ☐ Children required to remove clothing that has hoods and drawstrings.
- Children never left unsupervised.





Safety Procedures and Devices

- $\hfill \square$ Procedures for child drop-off/pick-up such as sign-in sheets and approved list of guardians.
- ☐ Caregiver certification in first-aid and CPR.
- Uworking carbon monoxide detectors.
- ☐ Working smoke detectors.
- Well stocked first-aid kit.
- \square Fire extinguishers inspection is current (see tag to determine when last inspected)
- DEvacuation plan.

Bathroom

- $\hfill \square$ Bathroom door can be easily opened from the exterior by an adult.
- $\ \square$ Bathroom door has a device that makes it close slowly and softly to prevent injury to hands.
- Cabinets and medicine cabinets have latches.
- ☐ Nothing dangerous is accesible by children.
- ☐ Children are never left unsupervised.
